As a result of this meeting Mr. Corcoran has withdrawn his Human Rights Application with no terms or conditions being requested or imposed on anyone. Following their meeting Bishop De Angelis and Mr. Corcoran prayed together and thanked God for his blessings. The parties to the proceedings will be making no further comments about the matter and thank the media in advance for respecting their decision in that regard.

Projects in the parish, including both those which need Diocesan approval and those which do not, the parish must follow Diocesan guidelines and policies, i.e., WSIB certificates, Insurance certificates, tendering of projects, etc. For projects above \$25,000, tenders are required. The contractors, selected by the parish in consultation with the diocese, will send their sealed tenders to the Chancery Office, where they will be opened in the presence of a representative(s) of the parish (finance committee / property, planning or building

committee(s). These procedures are followed by most dioceses and are required by law.
