Projects in the parish, including both those which need Diocesan approval and those which do not, the parish must follow Diocesan guidelines and policies, i.e., WSIB certificates, Insurance certificates, tendering of projects, etc. For projects above \$25,000, tenders are required. The contractors, selected by the parish in consultation with the diocese, will send their sealed tenders to the Chancery Office, where they will be opened in the presence of a representative(s) of the parish (finance committee / property, planning or building committee(s)). These procedures are followed by most dioceses and are required by law.
