Just an update on yours truly – the radiation treatments are continuing daily, and I should be all finished with them by around June 11, if not a little earlier. This past week I was having daily doses of chemotherapy as well as radiation--by the time you read this I should be finished with the chemo part of my treatments.

I don't know how I'm going to be feeling at the end of all this--many of you have been through it as well with your own experiences--so it'll be a day-to-day thing.

The doctors have said that the side effects of radiation and chemo can stay around for 2-4 weeks after treatments have ended, so I'll just have to keep monitoring my health as time goes by!

Thanks again to all of you for your kindness, cards, prayers, Masses, spiritual bouquets, food and desserts--it's been hard to keep track of all the kindness. Let me say this--that every card, gift, or meal that I open--I say a prayer right away for the one who gave it to me. So thanks-- and I can't wait to get back on the horse again when all this is over...--Fr David

Projects in the parish, including both those which need Diocesan approval and those which do not, the parish must follow Diocesan guidelines and policies, i.e., WSIB certificates, Insurance certificates, tendering of projects, etc. For projects above \$25,000, tenders are required. The contractors, selected by the parish in consultation with the diocese, will send their sealed tenders to the Chancery Office, where they will be opened in the presence of a representative(s) of the parish (finance committee / property, planning or building committee(s)). These procedures are followed by most dioceses and are required by law.
