Mass--are we doing enough for them??? If  
you have ideas about a youth group, or  
suggestions, please let me know....

### **THE EMERGENCY DEFIBRILATOR**

--(that the Parish, CWL and the Knights  
purchased over a year ago) thankfully  
has not been needed. It has been  
installed in the vestibule of the church since  
then, and yet I'm not sure how  
many parishioners are aware of how  
easy it is to use.

*If you're a nurse, EMT or have good  
knowledge of how to use it, please notify me. --  
The more you parishioners are aware of how  
to use it, the better off all of us will be. I'd like*

*to get a short training session set up--but I  
need to know how many are already familiar  
with it, and secondly, how many would like to

### **IF YOU ARE SICK OR IN HOSPITAL,**

please let me know. I will drop what I'm  
doing to visit you. If you or family members  
don't notify me, I just presume you're on  
holidays or out of town if I don't see you in  
Church!

**Funeral Servers** - I'm looking for a "few  
more Good Men and Women" (to paraphrase  
St. Paul) to serve at funeral Masses. This is a  
very important and beautiful Ministry to our  
families at their most difficult moments.  
Please let me know if you are committed to  
this service.

**ALTAR SERVERS---** We are always in need  
of new altar servers--in fact, we're running a  
little low!! Parents--if your son or daughter  
has received First Holy Communion, then  
they are ready to serve! Please contact me at  
the Parish Office.

**Speaking of Funerals** -- many times I am  
asked if "**cremation**" is allowed. Of course it  
is; and with limited space in some  
cemeteries, it may be a wise decision to  
make. It is preferred that the casket be  
brought to the Church for the Mass of  
Christian Burial (Funeral Mass) and then  
cremation takes place after. However, it is  
acceptable as well, if families wish, to bring  
the urn of cremated remains to the Church;  
much like a casket, the urn is brought up at  
the beginning of Mass by the family; it is  
placed on a small table with a white cloth  
covering it, and the Easter Candle beside it...  
**One rule however:** The urn of ashes **must** be  
buried or placed in a wall of repose, just like  
a casket is. Our Lord was entombed (buried).  
We too, follow his example. The remains  
should never be "kept on the mantle" or  
sprinkled or divided up. They are to be  
buried or reposed in a dignified Christian  
manner.
