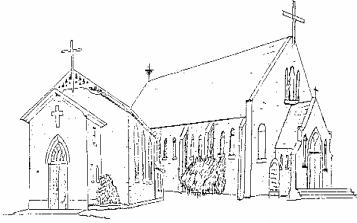

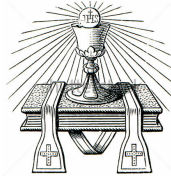

**CWL NEWS**



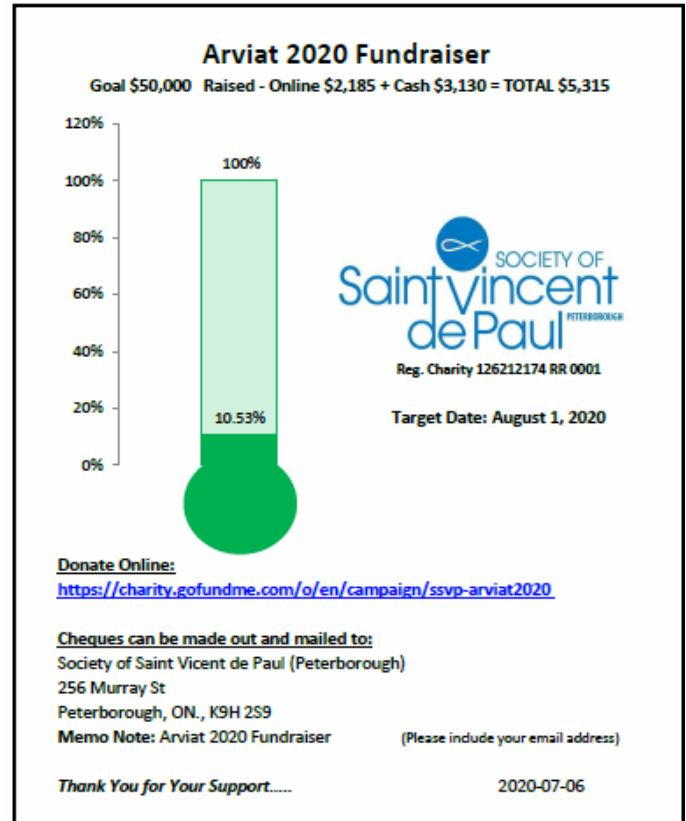
