
ADVENT MISSION---VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY, CAMPBELLFORD

World Youth Day Message----Pilgrims of Hope

At the request of the Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life, the CCCB General Secretariat forwards you the Holy Father's Message for the XXXIX World Youth Day. This year's theme, "Those who hope in the Lord... will run and not be weary" (Is 40:31), centres on hope and endurance in continuation of the two-year cycle linking the theme of the World Youth Days to the theme to the Great Jubilee, "Pilgrims of Hope."

The international celebration of World Youth Day is generally held every three years in a different country, each time with the participation of the Holy Father. The ordinary celebration of WYD, on the other hand, takes place every year, on the Solemnity of Christ the King, in the particular Churches that undertake the organisation of the the Holy Father's Message Thus, transmitted with this memo is intended to inspire and guide events in your diocese/eparchy this coming Solemnity of Christ the King, Sunday, 24 November 2024. The local celebration of this year's World Youth Day in your diocese or eparchy will help prepare the universal Church for her next major international celebrations of youth, the **Jubilee of Young People in 2025**, followed by World Youth Day in Seoul, Korea, in 2027.
