Simbang Gabi - Filipino for Night Mass

A devotional nine-day series of Novena & Masses attended by Filipino Catholics in anticipation of Christmas. Originally intended as a practical compromise for farmers that started working in the fields before sunrise. This cherished Christmas

custom eventually became a distinct feature of Philippine culture and became a symbol of sharing.

Simbang Gabi started in the Diocese of Peterborough in 2016 and in 2025 host church is the Cathedral of St. Peter In Chains where it started. It goes around in the city parishes and any donations collected during the nine days of Simbang Gabi are being turn-over to host parish. Begins December 15 – December 23. Mass at 6:30 followed by a light snack, on December 23 there will be a potluck at the Bishop Doyle Hall.

Bambinelli Sunday (3rd Sunday of Advent)

Bambinelli Sunday is an event that takes place in Rome on the third Sunday of Advent each year. The idea is to encourage everyone to bring their 'Bambinelli' to be blessed on the third Sunday of Advent, Ga udete Sunday. This blessing of the Christ 'Child is a way to help children focus on the real and true meaning of Christmas, the birth of Jesus. It is suggested that families, be encouraged to take the 'Bambinelli' home after the blessing, place



it in a special box and then wrap the box. Families open the gift on Christmas morning, before their presents, and place Jesus in the manger. It is advisable to mark your baby Jesus, so it is easily identifiable when collecting at the end of Mass.

The Season of Advent

Advent has a two fold nature: It prepares us for Christmas, when we recall Christ's first coming among us, and it is also a time when we look forward to his second coming at the end of the ages. Advent is a season of joyful expectation.

During Advent, each Sunday's Gospel reading has a specific focus. The Old Testament reading, especially those taken from Isaiah, are prophecies about the Messiah and messiannic times. The selections from the writings of the Apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of this season.
